
LT to measure in grams and kilograms.

LT to read o'clock and half past times on an analogue clock.


What time do these clocks say?




Now find some o'clock and half past times on the clocks in your house.

LT to record time on a clock.


Look at these times and draw the hands on the clocks to show them.








