



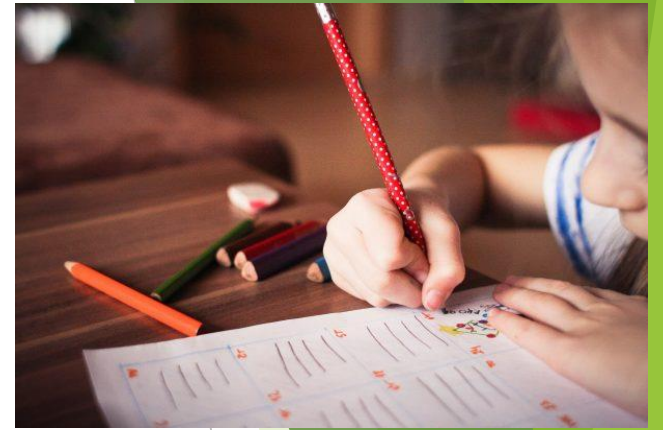

Have you been doing lots of exercise - Joe Wicks keep fit or Yoga Pirates?

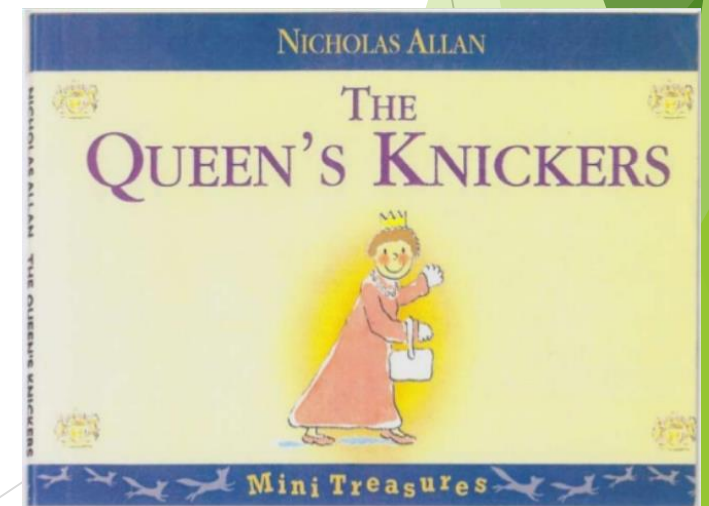

What special message will you write inside to let him know how amazing you think he is?



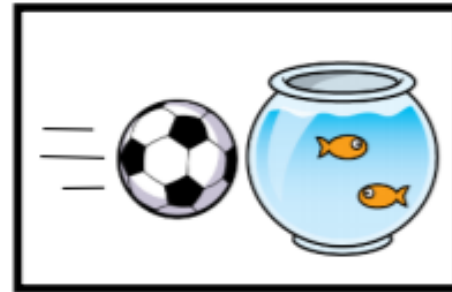
