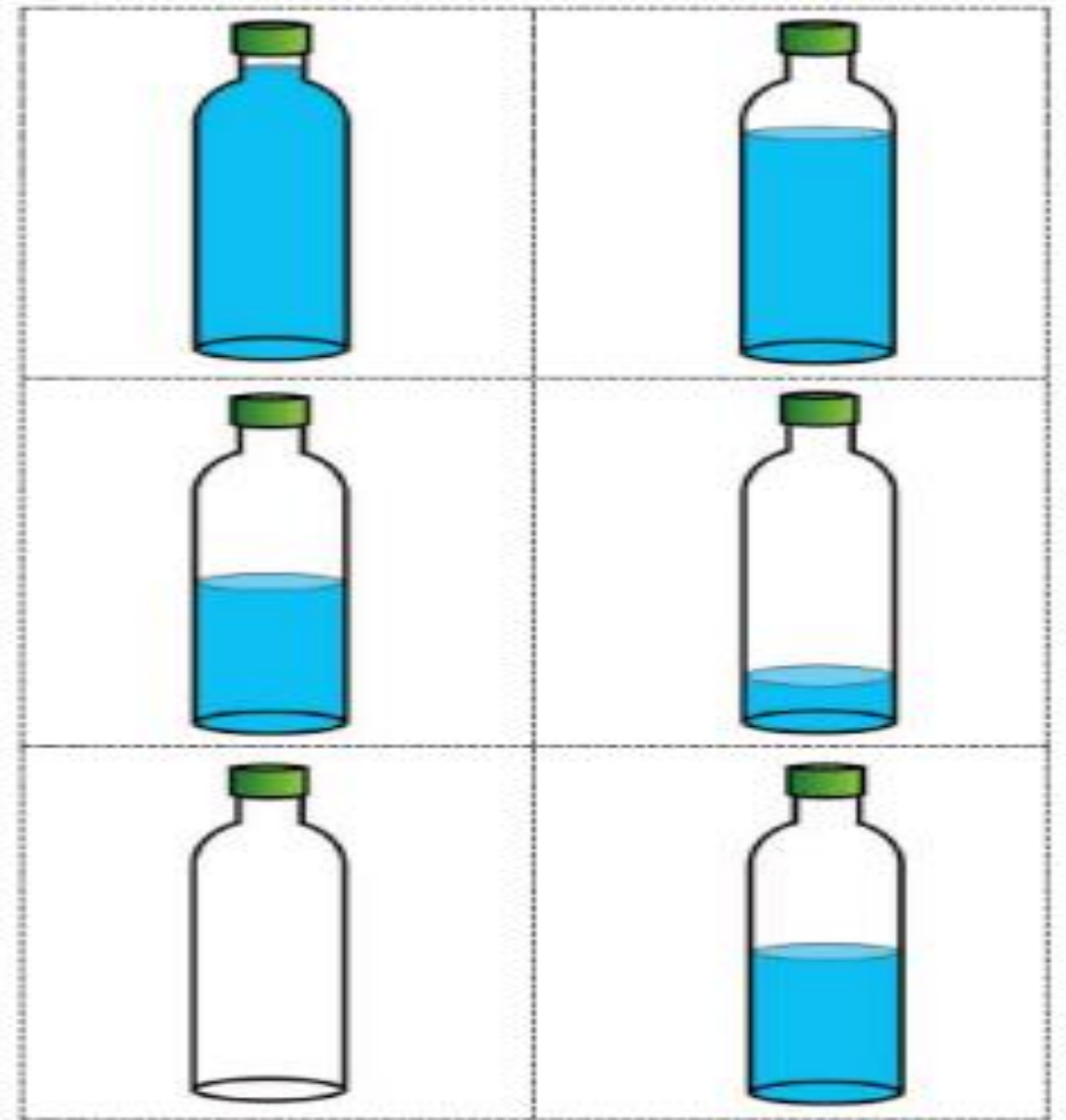


Maths lesson 2

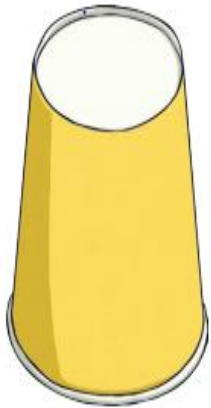

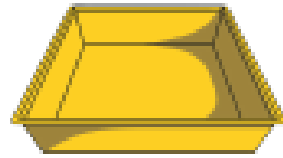

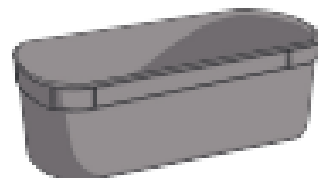



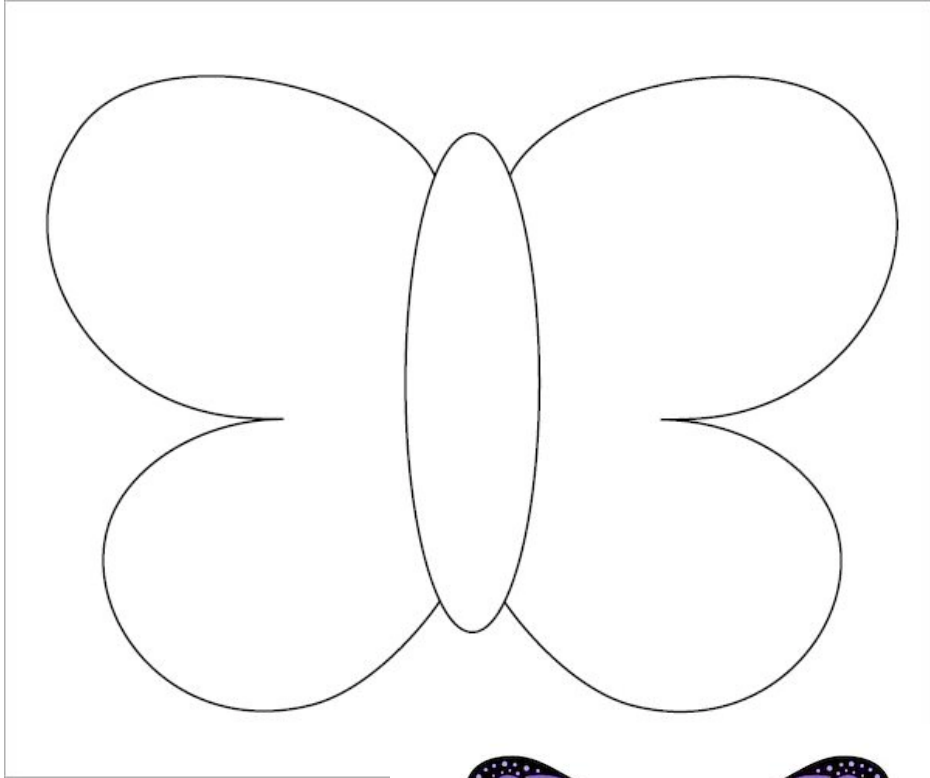
