Theme: The Secret Garden


Summer Term Week 2

Now have a go at spelling the days of the week. Remember to look, cover, say write and then check.













We are learning to write sentences using capital letters and full stops.

- 4. Have you remembered your capital letters and full stops?






We are learning to give peoples names a capital letter.

Write the letters q, g and d on the lines.




Maths lesson 1 LO to find one more, one less, ten more and ten less.

Practise finding one more, one less, ten more and ten less by using the hundred square to help. Can you add ten to find ten more without counting up ten squares? Have you notice a pattern.

Repeat this to reinforce the pattern.

Now take it in turns to play guess my number You need to say "I started with my number and then added on ten/subtracted ten/added one or subtracted one and this is my answer. What was my number?"

e.g. "I started with my number and then subtracted one and this is my answer 65. What was my number?"



LO to know what one more, one fewer, ten more and ten fewer than a number is.


Pick a two digit number and find out what one more, one fewer, ten more and ten fewer than is. One has been done to show you.
