RE: school closure on Thursday 17th and Friday 18th December

I am very proud of the work that all our staff are doing to keep our children and families safe. The demands placed on staff during this unprecedented time is very high. Some of this work is outside the normal role, responsibilities and hours of the staff, including carrying out cleaning duties to ensure the environment is maintained to the highest standard. Everyone is working flexibly to ensure the school is a clean, safe and happy environment.
