As part of our commitment to make maths exciting and high profile in our school, this November we are taking part in a competition for Maths Week England. It's called Rock Out 2020 and it's all carried out online through the TTRockstars site, <https://play.ttrockstars.com/>

When playing the games, for every correct answer to a multiplication or division question, your child will earn their class a point. The Times Tables Rock Stars platform will calculate the class average (the number of correct answers per pupil in the class who play during the competition hours). There will be prizes donated by TTRockstars for the schools and classes in the whole of the UK with the highest average points score.

All game modes (Gig, Garage, Studio, etc.) will generate points but only points scored from games played between **7.30am and 7.30pm** on Monday 9th, Tuesday 10th, Wednesday 11th, Thursday 12th, Friday 13th and Saturday 14th will count.

In the spirit of the competition, please don't play on their behalf, but by all means encourage and support them to earn points. We suggest a limit of half an hour a day outside school hours will be sufficient – some may play more, some may play less.
