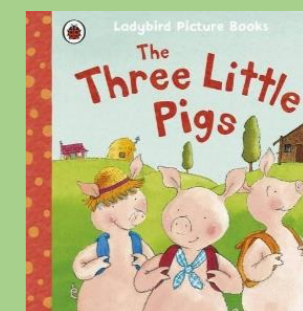

Foundation 2 – Mrs Adamson

Live Learning – provided through Zoom by Mrs Adamson, children will receive direct teaching. Mrs Adamson will teach the new learning during this session.

Remote learning – The children will use a weekly resource pack with an adult to help embed their learning and practice their skills.

Monday 11.01.21	<p>Live Learning - Zoom Meeting</p> <p>Learning Target: describe a character. Recall the characters from the story 'The Three Little Pigs'. Using the puppets/picture cards think of some words to describe what the characters look like and how they act.</p> <p>Phonics: Mrs Adamson will recap and revisit all the sounds taught so far in school. Introduce the new sound 'ai'.</p>	<p>Live Learning – Zoom Meeting</p> <p>Learning Target: know that there are four seasons, spring, summer, autumn and winter. Introduce the four seasons – spring, summer, autumn and winter. Share photographs of the different seasons.</p> <p>Maths Meeting</p>	<p>Live Learning – Zoom Meeting</p> <p>Circle Time</p> <p>Story Time</p>
	<p>Remote Learning – Learning at Home</p> <p>Use the 'Wanted Poster' from the pack. In the box draw or paint the Big Bad Wolf. Encourage your child to use as much detail as possible.</p> <p>Watch Mrs Adamson's phonics video - a link will be sent to you via text message. (There is a new one everyday). Encourage your child to join in saying the sounds and reading the words.</p>	<p>Remote Learning – Learning at Home</p> <p>Use the sheet in your pack (Monday Maths). Your child can colour the season pictures in. They then need to stick the months of the year around the circle matching the months with the correct seasons. Stick the sheet into the 'Lockdown Learning' book.</p> <p>Spring – March, April May Summer – June, July, August Autumn – September, October, November Winter – December, January, February</p>	
Tuesday 12.01.21	<p>Live Learning - Zoom Meeting</p> <p>Learning Target: write a label. Using a large cut out of the Big Bad Wolf the children will think of some words to describe him. Mrs Adamson will model writing the words as labels.</p> <p>Recap and revisit all the letters taught so far in school. Introduce the new sound 'ee'.</p>	<p>Live Learning – Zoom Meeting</p> <p>Learning Target: say the days of the week in order. Sing the days of the week song. Talk about what we do on each day of the week.</p> <p>Maths Meeting</p>	<p>Live Learning – Zoom Meeting</p> <p>PSHE Session</p> <p>Story Time</p>
	<p>Remote Learning – Learning at Home</p> <p>Watch Mrs Adamson's phonics video - a link will be sent to you via text message. (There is a new one everyday). Encourage your child to join in saying the sounds and reading the words.</p>	<p>Remote Learning – Learning at Home</p> <p>Use the days of the week labels (Tuesday Maths Cards) Stick them in the correct order in the 'Lockdown Learning' book.</p>	
Wednesday 13.01.21	<p>Live Learning - Zoom Meeting</p> <p>Learning Target: write a sentence. The children will share some simple sentences that they could write on their wanted posters. Mrs Adamson will scribe on to her wanted poster.</p>	<p>Live Learning – Zoom Meeting</p> <p>LT: talk about and sequence daily events. Sequence images using the words: first, next, last, before, after, morning, afternoon evening.</p>	<p>Live Learning – Zoom Meeting</p> <p>Active Maths</p> <p>Story Time</p>

	<p>Recap and revisit all the letters taught so far in school. Introduce the new sound 'igh'.</p> <p>Remote Learning – Learning at Home</p> <p>Support your child to write a simple sentence on their wanted poster. i.e He is big and bad. He has big teeth. Stick the sheet into the 'Lockdown Learning' book.</p> <p>Watch Mrs Adamson's phonics video - a link will be sent to you via text message. (There is a new one everyday). Encourage your child to join in saying the sounds and reading the words.</p>	<p>Maths Meeting</p> <p>Remote Learning – Learning at Home</p> <p>Use the daily routine picture cards (Wednesday Maths), encourage your child to arrange them in the order that they get ready to go to bed in an evening. Stick into the 'Lockdown Learning' book.</p>	
<p>Thursday 14.01.21</p>	<p>Live Learning – Zoom Meeting</p> <p>Learning Target: blend to read some captions. Using words containing the sounds that we have learnt so far in phonics blend to read some captions and match them to the pictures.</p> <p>Recap and revisit all the letters taught so far in school. Introduce the new sound 'oa'.</p> <p>Remote Learning – Learning at Home</p> <p>Read the captions. Match them to the correct pictures. Stick the matching pairs in to the 'Lockdown Learning' book.</p> <p>Watch Mrs Adamson's phonics video - a link will be sent to you via text message. (There is a new one everyday). Encourage your child to join in saying the sounds and reading the words.</p>	<p>Live Learning – Zoom Meeting</p> <p>Learning Target: say the months of the year in order. Sing the months of the year song. Talk about what happens in some of the months of the year.</p> <p>Maths Meeting</p> <p>Remote Learning – Learning at Home</p> <p>Use the months of the year labels (Thursday Maths Cards) Stick them in the correct order in the 'Lockdown Learning' book.</p>	<p>Live Learning – Zoom Meeting</p> <p>Circle Time</p> <p>Story Time</p>
<p>Friday 15.01.21</p>	<p>Remote Learning – Learning at Home</p> <p>Play the tricky word bingo set in your pack. Can your child read all the words? Remember these are 'tricky' to blend so they need to read them by sight.</p> <p>Watch Mrs Adamson's phonics video a link will be sent to you via text message (there is a new one everyday).</p> <p>Encourage your child to join in saying the sounds and reading the words.</p>	<p>Remote Learning – Learning at Home</p> <p>Watch Seasons Video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=8Zjpl6fgYSY</p> <p>Watch the Months of the Year Song: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=omkuE6Wa5kQ</p>	<p>Parents and children – relax!
