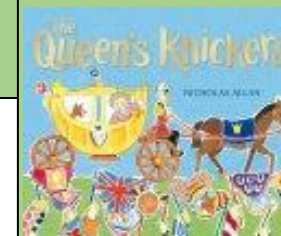


**Marshland Primary Academy
