Coronavirus Awareness

Sun Awareness

As the weather turns warmer, we ask parents to think about protecting their child from the sun. Unfortunately, staff members are not allowed to apply any sun cream so we recommend parents apply sun cream to their child in the morning before they come to school. They may wish to give their child a NAMED sunhat to wear at lunchtime. Children will not be allowed to wear sunglasses at school because of the risk of injury when they are playing.

Water Bottle

We would like to ensure that all children are provided with a NAMED water bottle for them to drink from during the day. It is important for children to stay hydrated throughout the day by drinking regularly and with the risks of Coronavirus, it is essential that children do not share water bottles or cups.
